About YSU Meal Plans

What are Meal Plans and Pete's Points?

There are many great places to eat on the YSU campus. To help you enjoy the variety, YSU offers **Meal Plans** and **Pete's Points**.

Meal Plans are prepaid accounts which allow you to dine or snack at our many campus eateries. The plan you purchase will be recorded on your YSU ID card. It will track your usage of the program and

serve as a form of payment. No need to carry cash!

Choose the plan that is best for you. Whether you eat three meals a day, or just lunch, dinner, and a between-class snack—our Meal Plans are designed to fit your eating habits. See the charts below for the many Meal Plan options.

Pete's Points are a debit style account of extra money in addition to your meal plan. Pete's Points can be used at any time of day—with no limits on how much

you can spend each day, as long as you do not exceed your balance.

Pete's Points can be used like cash (\$1.00 in points = \$1.00 in cash) toward food purchases.

Important Information

You need to know that **Sodexo** is the name of the world-class company which runs most of the dining locations on campus. One of Sodexo's dining locations is Christman Dining Commons, a traditional all-you-care-to-eat dining hall. At Christman, one "**swipe**" of your YSU ID pays for the *entire* meal. However, at other Sodexo dining locations on campus, you will be able to "swipe" your card to dine. With a meal "swipe", you will have a variety of meal combos to choose from at each retail location.

Meal Time Zones

4 Meals A Day

Whatever Meal Plan you purchase, you are limited to 4 meal "swipes" a day. You can use up to 2 swipes per **Meal Time Zone**. What is a Meal Time Zone, you ask? These are four distinct blocks of time when you can "swipe in" for breakfast, lunch, dinner, and "late night." Pay attention to

Meal Plans for Residents

If you live in a YSU residence hall (excluding Weller House), your meal plan is included in your room and board. At the beginning of each semester, you will automatically be signed up for our most popular plan, the 14 Meal Plan. During the first 11 class days of each semester, you may change your plan to any of those listed here. To do so, visit the Card Office in the Kilcawley Center Staff Offices, and bring your YSU ID.

 Lunch: 10:31am – 4:00pm
 Dinner: 4:01pm – 8:00pm
 Late Night: 9:00pm – Midnight

The schedule for meal plans runs from Monday breakfast through Sunday late night.

the times that you eat so that you do not run out of “swipes” for any given meal time or day. Know that unused meal swipes for the week expire Sunday evening and are forfeited.

Block Meal Plan

With the Block Plan, you are allotted a specified number of meals to be used during the course of the semester. As with other Meal Plans, you are limited to 4 meal “swipes” a day, and 2 “swipes” per Meal Time Zone. The advantage of the

Block Plan is that your “leftover swipes” DO carry over from week to week. You have access to them for the entire semester. Remember, on the Block Plan, it is your responsibility to manage the number of swipes you use. Be sure that you make them last throughout the semester.

For residents of University Housing, the Block Plan is only available to residents who have lived on campus for two full (fall or spring) semesters.

Your Guests

Whatever your Meal Plan, you are permitted to use your available meal “swipes,” and Pete’s Points for guests if you wish to do so.

Pete’s Points Plan

The Pete’s Points Plan is a prepaid account allowing you to dine or snack at any of our campus eateries. Your YSU ID is your form of payment. Plan does not include meal “swipes.” Instead \$1.00 of Pete’s Points = \$1.00 cash. You choose how many points you would like to add to the plan (must be a minimum of \$25). Points can be added at any time and as many times as wanted throughout the semester. Points are added at the Card Office in the Kilcawley Center Staff Offices. Pete’s Points expire at the end of each semester. No refunds will be given.

Frequently Asked Questions

What If I Don't Use All of My Points?

Unused Pete's Points expire for everyone at the end of EACH semester. No refunds will be given, so remember to use all of your Pete's Points!

What If I Run Out of Points?

You can purchase more Pete's Points with a deposit (cash/check/credit) of \$25 or more in the Card Office in the Kilcawley Center Staff Office Monday – Friday 8:30am – 4:00pm.

Can I Treat My Parents?

Parents EAT FREE at Christman Dining Commons when dining with their resident student.

What If I Lose My ID?

How Can I Get a Temp Card?

If you lose your ID, you will need to stop in the Card Office in the Kilcawley Center Staff Office Monday through Friday 8:30am – 4:00pm. A photo ID is required for this.

How Can I Get a New ID?

YSU student IDs can be replaced at the Registrar's Office or the Card Office in Kilcawley Center for a \$25 fee.
